4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Chapter 8 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new

8	"Insurance Coverage.
9	" <u>§ 8-115. Evidence of insurance coverage admissible.</u>
10	In any civil proceeding, including the questioning of jurors under G.S. 9-15, counsel of
11	record for the plaintiffs may present evidence or inquire regarding the existence, contents, and
12	coverage of any liability insurance policies held by any defendant."
13	SECTION 2. Rule 411 of the North Carolina Rules of Evidence, as contained in
14	G.S. 8C-1, is repealed.
15	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to any cause
16	of action arising on or after that date.



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
