5	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-141.4(b) reads as rewritten:	
6	"(b) Punishments. – Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law	
7	providing greater punishment, the following classifications apply to the offenses set forth in	
8	this section:	
9	(1) Aggravated felony death by vehicle is a Class D felony.	
10	(2) Felony death by vehicle is a Class E felony.	
11	(3) Aggravated felony serious injury by vehicle is a Class E felony.	
12	(4) Felony serious injury by vehicle is a Class F felony.	
13	(5) Misdemeanor death by vehicle is a Class <u>4-A1</u> misdemeanor."	
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to	
15	offenses committed on or after that date.
