A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO BE ALLOCATED TO APPALACHIAN STATE UNIVERSITY TO CONSTRUCT A NEW FACILITY FOR ITS COLLEGE OF HEALTH SCIENCES AND ALLIED PROFESSIONS.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifty-four million dollars (\$54,000,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year to be allocated to Appalachian State University to construct a facility for the College of Health Sciences and Allied Professions. The building complex will be constructed in association with Watauga Medical Center. The new College and facility will enable Appalachian State University to attract more students and educate more health care professionals.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
