A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE TARHEEL CHALLENGE PROGRAM TO A SECOND  
CAMPUS TO BE LOCATED IN BADIN, NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 7.13(f) of S.L. 2009-451, of the funds appropriated in S.L. 2009-451 for dropout prevention, the sum of eight hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$875,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year shall be used to assist the National Guard in converting, establishing, and beginning operations at a second Tarheel ChalleNGe campus to be located in Badin, North Carolina. Tarheel ChalleNGe, Inc., is a nonprofit corporation associated with the National Guard that helps high school dropouts earn their General Education Development diplomas and develop other life skills necessary to become productive citizens.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
