1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE ALL STATE AGENCIES PRODUCING ARCHAEOLOGICAL  
3 RESEARCH TO PROVIDE ANNUAL REPORTS TO THE COMMISSION OF INDIAN  
4 AFFAIRS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 70 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new  
7 Article to read:

8 "Article 5.

9 "Annual Archaeological Reports.

10 "**§ 70-55. Annual archaeological reports.**

11 The Department of Cultural Resources, The University of North Carolina System, the  
12 Department of Transportation, and all other State agencies that perform archaeological or  
13 archaeologically-related functions for the State of North Carolina shall provide annual reports  
14 of their archaeological research, including any findings and conclusions resulting from that  
15 research, to the Commission of Indian Affairs. If practicable, the Department of Cultural  
16 Resources may coordinate with the other State agencies to produce a single annual report under  
17 this section."

18 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
