14			150B of the General Statutes. Such rules may provide that minor activities			
15			may occur under a general permit issued in accordance with conditions set			
16			out in such rules. All persons covered under general permits shall be subject			
17			to all enforcement procedures and remedies applicable under this Article.			
18			Prior to reissuing, revising, or replacing a general permit, the Commission			
19			shall provide advance notice of the reissued, revised, or replacement general			
20			permit and of any public meetings held by the Commission or by the			
21			Department regarding the reissuance, revision, or replacement of the general			
22			permit to all permittees covered by the general permit using any of the			
23			following methods:			
24			a. Deposit in the United States mail of such notice in an envelope with			
25			postage prepaid, addressed to the permittee at his address as shown			
26			by the records of the Department.			
27			b. Delivery of such notice via facsimile or electronic mail to the			
28			facsimile number or electronic mail address of the permittee as			
29			shown by the records of the Department.
