A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE LAW REGARDING BUILDING CODE STANDARDS FOR
BUILDINGS USED BY HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ATTENDING CLASSES ON
COMMUNITY COLLEGE CAMPUSES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 115D-41(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) ~~Community-Existing community~~ college facilities that comply with ~~applicable State, county, and local fire codes~~ the North Carolina State Building Code and applicable local ordinances for community college facilities may be used without modification for public school students in joint or cooperative programs such as middle or early college programs and dual enrollment programs. Designs for new community college facilities that comply with the North Carolina State Building Code and applicable local ordinances for community college facilities also may be used without modification for these students.

For the purpose of establishing Use and Occupancy Classifications, these programs shall be considered 'Business – Group B' in the same manner as other community college uses."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
