A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND  
HUMAN SERVICES FOR A STATEWIDE LEADERSHIP TRAINING INITIATIVE  
FOR CONSUMER AND FAMILY ADVISORY COMMITTEES (CFAC).

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated to support a statewide leadership training initiative for Consumer and Family Advisory Committees, established pursuant to Part 4A of Article 4 of Chapter 122C of the General Statutes.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
