A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM OR ACROSS THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF A  
2 PORTION OF STATE ROAD 1862, KNOWN AS JOYNER DRIVE, IN CRAVEN  
3 COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Unless a person owns or possesses a leasehold interest in the real  
7 property immediately adjacent to the portion of the road on which the person is located, it is  
8 unlawful for that person to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird with firearms from,  
9 on, or across the right-of-way of State Secondary Road 1862, known as Joyner Drive, from  
10 Adams Creek Road to the end of the State-maintained portion of the road.

11 **SECTION 2.** Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

12 **SECTION 3.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife  
13 Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general  
14 subject matter jurisdiction.

15 **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Craven County.

16 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
