9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
10	SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2007-333, as rewritten by Section 1 of S.L.
11	2009-149, reads as rewritten:
12	"SECTION 1.(a) The City of Raleigh A municipality may contract for apparatus, supplies,
13	materials, or equipment that will be used as part of any pilot program authorized by the City
14	Council-its governing board aimed at increasing energy efficiency without being subject to the
15	requirements of G.S. 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132. Notwithstanding any provision of law,
16	the City-municipality may award a contract under this section in its sole discretion.
17	"SECTION 1.(b) This section applies to the City of Raleigh and the Town of Chapel Hill
18	<u>only.</u> "
19	SECTION 2. Section 3 of S.L. 2009-149 reads as rewritten:
20	"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act applies to the City-Cities of Raleigh and the City of
21	Winston-Salem and the Town of Chapel Hill only."
22	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
