A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REDUCE INFANT MORTALITY AND REDUCE PRETERM BIRTHS, AS
RECOMMENDED BY THE CHILD FATALITY TASK FORCE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Medical 6 Assistance, shall seek a Medicaid 1115 waiver or implement other available Medicaid options 7 to provide interconceptional coverage to low-income women with incomes below one hundred 8 eight-five percent (185%) of the federal poverty guidelines who have given birth to a high-risk 9 infant. A high-risk infant is defined as weighing less than 1500 grams, is born less than 34 10 weeks gestation, is born with a congenital anomaly, or who has died within the first 28 days of 11 life.

SECTION 2. Interconceptional care shall be limited to two years following the
birth of a high-risk infant, or until a subsequent birth, whichever comes first.

14 **SECTION 3.** The Division is authorized to develop a benefit package to improve 15 interconceptional care to decrease poor birth outcomes in subsequent pregnancies.

16 **SECTION 4.** The Division shall provide estimates of the cost savings from 17 improved birth outcomes that will offset the cost of providing Medicaid coverage to this 18 targeted population.

SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
