A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SUNSET ON THE LAW AUTHORIZING TEACHERS TO TAKE PERSONAL LEAVE WITHOUT PENALTY UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1 of S.L. 2008-209 is repealed.

**SECTION 2.** Section 3 of S.L. 2008-209 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 3.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes law. ~~Section 2 expires at the same time that the amendment to G.S. 115C-302.1(d) made by House Bill 2436, 2007 Regular Session, expires.~~"

**SECTION 3.** Section 26.21(b) of S.L. 2008-107 is repealed.

**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to implement this act.

**SECTION 5.** Section 4 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2009. The remainder of this act becomes effective June 30, 2009.
