SENATE BILL 550

Short Title: Duplin Elections. (Local)

Sponsors: Senator Albertson.

Referred to: State and Local Government.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL MEMBER TO THE DUPLIN COUNTY BOARD OF  
EDUCATION AND THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DUPLIN COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 1 of Chapter 966 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as  
rewritten:

"Section 1. ~~Except as provided in Section 4 of this act following the 1988 elections the~~  
Effective the first Monday in December of 2010, the Duplin County Board of Commissioners  
and Board of Education shall each consist of ~~six~~ seven members elected in partisan ~~elections~~  
elections, one each from the six districts described in Section 8-8, and one from the county at  
large. Only voters who reside in a district may vote in the party primaries and general elections  
for that district."

**SECTION 2.** Section 5 of Chapter 966 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as  
rewritten:

"Sec. 5. In 1990 and every four years thereafter, one commissioner each shall be elected  
from Districts II and III. In 1992 and every four years thereafter, one commissioner each shall  
be elected from Districts I, IV, V and VI. In 2010 and every four years thereafter, one  
commissioner shall be elected at large."

**SECTION 3.** Section 6 of Chapter 966 of the 1987 Session Laws reads as  
rewritten:

"Sec. 6. In 1988 and every four years thereafter, three members shall be elected to the  
Board of Education, one each from Districts I, V and VI. The three other members of the Board  
of Education shall be elected in 1990 and every four years thereafter. In those years one  
member each shall be elected from Districts II, III and IV. In 2010 and every four years  
thereafter, one member shall be elected at large."

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
