2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A CORPORATION THAT IS A MANUFACTURER,		
3	WHOLESALE DEALER, OR RETAIL DEALER OF CROSSBOWS THAT OBTAINS A		
4	PERMIT FOR THE SALE, RECEIPT, OR OTHER TRANSFER OF A CROSSBOW IS		
5	DEEMED TO HAVE A CONTINUING PERMIT THAT AUTHORIZES THE FUTURE		
6	SALE, GIVEAWAY, TRANSFER, PURCHASE, OR RECEIPT OF CROSSBOWS BY		
7	THE CORPORATION AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE RECORD-KEEPING		
8	REQUIREMENT FOR SALES OF CROSSBOWS DOES NOT APPLY TO A		
9	MANUFACTURER OF CROSSBOWS AND DOES NOT APPLY TO A WHOLESALE		
10	DEALER OF CROSSBOWS WHEN THE SALES ARE TO OTHER WHOLESALE		
11	DEALERS OR RETAIL DEALERS.		
12	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
13	SECTION 1. Article 52A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by		
14	adding a new section to read:		
15	"§ 14-406.1. Permit issued to manufacturer, wholesale dealer, or retail dealer of		
16	crossbows deemed to be a continuing permit.		
17	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, if a corporation that is a		
18	manufacturer of crossbows, wholesale dealer of crossbows, or retail dealer of crossbows		
19	obtains a permit pursuant to this Article for the sale, giveaway, transfer, purchase, or receipt of		
20	a crossbow, the permit is deemed to be a continuing permit with no expiration date that satisfies		
21	the permitting requirements under this Article for each future sale, giveaway, transfer,		
22	purchase, or receipt of a crossbow by the corporation.		
23	(b) A sheriff who issues a continuing permit under this section shall note in writing on		
24	the permit that, pursuant to this section, the permit is deemed to be a continuing permit with no		
25	expiration date.		
26	(c) Notwithstanding G.S. 14-402, a manufacturer of crossbows, wholesale dealer of		
27	crossbows, or retail dealer of crossbows that is issued a permit under this section may receive a		
28	crossbow delivered to the manufacturer, wholesale dealer, or retail dealer in the course of		
29	business without exhibiting the continuing permit to the person delivering the crossbow."

1	(2)	Bolt. – A projectile made to be discharged from a crossbow. The bolt differs	
2		from an arrow in that the bolt is heavier and shorter than an arrow.	
3	(3)	Crossbow A mechanical device consisting of, but not limited to, strings,	
4		cables, and prods transversely mounted on either a shoulder or hand-held	
5		stock. This device is mechanically held at full or partial draw and released	
6		by a trigger or similar mechanism that is incorporated into a stock or handle.	
7		When operated, the crossbow discharges a projectile known as a bolt.	
8	(4)	Historic edged weapon. – Defined in G.S. 14-409.12.	
9	<u>(5)</u>	Manufacturer of crossbows. – A corporation that manufactures or produces	
10		crossbows.	
11	<u>(6)</u>	Retail dealer of crossbows A corporation that sells crossbows to the	
12		ultimate consumer of the product.	
13	<u>(7)</u>	Wholesale dealer of crossbows. – A corporation that acquires crossbows for	
14		sale to another wholesale dealer of crossbows or to a retail dealer of	
15		<u>crossbows.</u> "

19	accurate record of all sales thereof, including the name, place of residence, date of sale, etc., of		
20	each person, firm, or corporation to whom or which such sales are made, which record shall be		
21	open to the inspe	ction of any duly constituted State, county or police officer, within this State.	
22	(b) This s	section does not apply to any of the following:	
23	<u>(1)</u>	A manufacturer of crossbows.	
24	<u>(2)</u>	A wholesale dealer of crossbows for any sale that is either to another	
25		wholesale dealer of crossbows or to a retail dealer of crossbows."
