 - An individual described in subsection (a) of this section may submit a voter registration application online using the procedures set forth in this section. The State Board of Elections shall establish a secure Internet Web site to permit individuals described in subsection (a) of this section to submit online applications under this section.
 - The secure Web site established under subsection (b) of this section shall allow an individual described in subsection (a) of this section to submit:
 - An application for the following: (1)
 - To register to vote. <u>a.</u>
 - To report a change of name, address, or party affiliation. If the b. applicant is already registered to vote, and the change of address is to another county, it shall be treated as an application to register to vote.
 - Information to establish that the applicant is eligible under this section to <u>(2)</u> register online.
 - When an applicant submits an application under this section the Division of Motor Vehicles shall compare the information submitted by the applicant with the information maintained in its database listing individuals who possess a current and valid North Carolina license, permit, or card specified under subdivision (a)(2) of this section.
 - If the Division of Motor Vehicles confirms that the applicant possesses either a current and valid:
 - (1) North Carolina drivers license issued under Article 2 of Section 20 of the General Statutes, including a learner's permit or a provisional license, or
 - (2) Special identification card for nonoperators issued under G.S. 20-37.7, the completed application and information compiled by the Division of Motor Vehicles (including the digital signature of the applicant in the Division of Motor Vehicles records) shall be submitted to the county board of elections in which the applicant currently resides in accordance with procedures established by the State Board of Elections.
 - If the Division of Motor Vehicles is unable to confirm that the applicant possesses either a current and valid:
 - North Carolina drivers license issued under Article 2 of Section 20 of the (1) General Statutes, including a learner's permit or a provisional license, or
 - special identification card for nonoperators issued under G.S. 20-37.7, (2) the Division of Motor Vehicles shall send to the county board of elections of the county in which the applicant currently resides, the application submitted by the applicant and information indicating that the Division of Motor Vehicles cannot confirm the information and that the applicant's application cannot be processed. The county board of elections shall notify the applicant of this fact by U.S. mail, and by e-mail if the applicant provided an e-mail address with the online registration."
 - **SECTION 3.** This section becomes effective December 1, 2011.
