A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 2 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE SURVIVOR'S ALTERNATE BENEFIT TO SURVIVORS OF 3 FIREFIGHTERS AND RESCUE SQUAD WORKERS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE 4 LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND ARE 5 KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 SECTION 1. G.S. 128-21 is amended by adding two new subdivisions to read: 8 "(7b) "Firefighter" means a person (i) who is a full-time paid employee of an 9 employer that participates in the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System and maintains a fire department certified by the North 10 Carolina Department of Insurance and (ii) who is actively serving in a 11 position with assigned primary duties and responsibilities for the prevention, 12 13 detection, and suppression of fire. "Rescue squad worker" means a person (i) who is a full-time paid employee 14 (7c) of an employer that participates in the Local Governmental Employees' 15 16 Retirement System and maintains a rescue squad or emergency medical services team certified by the North Carolina Department of Insurance or the 17 Department of Health and Human Services and (ii) who is actively serving 18 19 in a position with assigned primary duties and responsibilities for the 20 alleviation of human suffering and assistance to persons who are in difficulty, who are injured, or who become suddenly ill, by providing proper 21 22 and efficient care or emergency medical services." **SECTION 2.** G.S. 128-27(m) reads as rewritten: 23 Survivor's Alternate Benefit. - Upon the death of a member in service, the 24 "(m) 25 beneficiary designated to receive a return of accumulated contributions shall have the right to elect to receive in lieu thereof the reduced retirement allowance provided by Option two of 26 27 subsection (g) above computed by assuming that the member had retired on the first day of the 28 month following the date of his death, provided that all four of the following conditions apply: 29 The member had attained such age and/or creditable service to be (1)a. 30 eligible to commence retirement with an early or service retirement 31 allowance, or

32 b. The member had obtained 20 years of creditable service in which 33 case the retirement allowance shall be computed in accordance with 34 G.S. 128-27(b21)(1)b. or G.S. 128-27(b21)(2)c., notwithstanding the 35 requirement of obtaining age 50, or
