18 "**§ 20-79.4. Special registration plates.**

 20 (b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

 22 (14) Autism Society of North Carolina. – Issuable to the registered owner of a
 23 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
 24 phrase "~~Autism Society of North Carolina~~", ~~the phrase "Providing Support,~~
 25 ~~Promoting Opportunities"~~, "Autism Society of North Carolina" and the logo
 26 of the Autism Society.

 28 (68) Hospice Care. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
 29 accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Hospice
 30 Care" and the letters "~~HC~~" ~~on the right side of the plate.~~ "HC."

31 ...
 32 (91) National Kidney Foundation. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor
 33 vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear a phrase and
 34 logo ~~selected by~~ representing the Foundation.

35 ...
 36 (103) North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation. – Issuable to the owner of a
 37 motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the
 38 logo of the North Carolina Wildlife Habitat ~~Foundation on the left side and~~
 39 ~~the background of the entire plate shall be beige or tan color. The numbers~~
 40 ~~or other writing on the plate shall be black and the border shall be black. The~~
 41 ~~plate shall be developed by the Division in consultation with and approved~~
 42 ~~by the North Carolina Wildlife Habitat Foundation.~~ Foundation. The
 43 Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it
 44 receives at least 300 applications for the plate.

46 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-81.12(a) reads as rewritten:

47 "(a) Collegiate Insignia Plates. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for
 48 a collegiate insignia license plate for a college or university before a collegiate license plate
 49 may be developed. The color, design, and material for the plate must be ~~approved by both the~~
 50 ~~Division and developed in consultation with~~ the alumni or alumnae association of the
 51 appropriate college or university. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the

1 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of in-State collegiate
2 insignia plates to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina for in-State,
3 public colleges and universities and to the respective board of trustees for in-State, private
4 colleges and universities in proportion to the number of collegiate plates sold representing that
5 institution for use for academic enhancement."

6 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
