SENATE BILL 631

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF
NORTH CAROLINA TO RECOGNIZE THE CHEROKEE LANGUAGE AS A
LANGUAGE FOR WHICH A STUDENT MAY RECEIVE FOREIGN LANGUAGE
CREDIT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 116-11 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(4c) The Board of Governors shall require each constituent institution to develop and implement a policy that recognizes the Cherokee language as a language for which a student may receive foreign language credit that counts toward the satisfaction of the foreign language course requirement at the institution."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to the 2011-2012 academic year and each subsequent year.
