Failure of a board to comply with 8 the reporting requirements of this section by October 31 of each year shall result in a 9 suspension of the board's authority to expend any funds until such time as the board files the 10 required reports. Suspension of a board's authority to expend funds under this subsection shall 11 not affect the board's duty to issue and renew licenses or the validity of any application or 12 license for which fees have been tendered in accordance with law. Each board shall adopt rules 13 establishing a procedure for implementing this subsection and shall maintain an escrow account 14 into which any fees tendered during a board's period of suspension under this subsection shall

- 15 be deposited."
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SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
