3	FROM THE SALES TAX IMPOSED ON AN ADMISSION CHARGE TO AN

5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. If House Bill 1050, 2013 Regular Session, becomes law, then
7	G.S. 105-164.4G(f), as enacted by House Bill 1050, reads as rewritten:
8	"(f) Exemptions. – The following gross receipts derived from an admission charge to an
9	entertainment activity are specifically exempt from the tax imposed by this Article:
10	
11	(6) A commercial agricultural fair that meets the requirements of
12	G.S. 106-520.1, as determined by the Commissioner of Agriculture."
13	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2015, and applies to gross
14	receipts derived on or after that date.
