1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO CORRECT ELECTIONS MADE OUTSIDE OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY  
3 TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF CENTRAL CAROLINA COMMUNITY  
4 COLLEGE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The terms of all individuals elected solely by the Lee County Board  
7 of Education to the Board of Trustees of Central Carolina Community College shall expire  
8 effective August 1, 2013.

9 **SECTION 2.** No later than August 1, 2013, as required by G.S. 115D-12(a) for  
10 elections to Group One of the board of trustees for a community college, four trustees shall be  
11 jointly elected to the Central Carolina Community College Board of Trustees by the Board of  
12 Education of Chatham County, the Board of Education of Lee County, and the Board of  
13 Education of Harnett County with each board having one vote in the election of each trustee.  
14 No board of education shall elect a member of the board of education or any person employed  
15 by the board of education to serve as a trustee. No board of education shall reelect an individual  
16 elected solely by the Lee County Board of Education whose term expires August 1, 2013, as  
17 provided in Section 1 of this act, to one of the terms of office provided in Section 3 of this act.

18 **SECTION 3.** The four trustees elected as provided in Section 2 of this act shall  
19 serve the following terms:

- 20 (1) One trustee shall be elected to a one-year term expiring July 1, 2014, and  
21 quadrennially thereafter.  
22 (2) One trustee shall be elected to a two-year term expiring July 1, 2015, and  
23 quadrennially thereafter.  
24 (3) One trustee shall be elected to a three-year term expiring July 1, 2016, and  
25 quadrennially thereafter.  
26 (4) One trustee shall be elected to a four-year term expiring July 1, 2017, and  
27 quadrennially thereafter.

28 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
