General Assembly of North Carolina Session 2013 1 In addition, any bedding material made available to dogs shall be clean and not pose a risk 2 to the dogs. 3 Any person who owns, has custody of, or maintains 10 or more female dogs over (b) 4 the age of six months that are capable of reproduction and kept primarily for the purpose of 5 breeding and selling the offspring as pets shall keep the facility and primary enclosures clean and free from debris and odor and shall remove feces and dispose of them as frequently as 6 7 necessary so as not to pose a threat to the health of the dogs. 8 Failure to comply with the standards established under subsections (a) and (b) of (c) 9 this section constitutes a Class 3 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per animal nor more than a total of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), unless the 10 11 person has previously pled guilty or nolo contendere to, or been found guilty of, a violation of 12 this section, in which case each such violation is a Class A1 misdemeanor. Each violation shall 13 constitute a separate offense. The provisions of this section are in addition to, and not in lieu of, any other State or 14 (d) federal laws protecting animal welfare. This section shall not be construed to limit any State 15 16 law or regulation protecting the welfare of animals, nor shall anything in this section prevent a 17 local governing body from adopting and enforcing its own animal welfare laws and regulations 18 in addition to this section. This section shall not be construed to place any numerical limits on 19 the number of dogs a person may own or control or to regulate persons' ownership of dogs 20 when those dogs are not used for breeding and selling any offspring for use as a pet. Nothing in 21 this section shall be construed to limit hunting or the ability to breed, raise, sell, control, train, 22 or possess dogs with the intention to use those dogs for hunting or other sporting purposes. 23 This section does not apply to kennels operated solely for the purpose of boarding (e) 24 dogs or kennels exclusively used for training dogs for hunting, sporting, field trials, or show." 25 **SECTION 2.** If any provision of this act, or the application of this act to any 26 person or circumstances, is held invalid or unconstitutional, that invalidity or 27 unconstitutionality shall not affect other provisions or applications of this act that can be given 28 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the 29 provisions of this act are severable. 30 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to

31 offenses committed on or after that date.
