	and analysis of data relating to workers' compensation claims for the purpose
	of preventing and detecting fraud, as follows:
	a. The North Carolina Industrial Commission shall release to GBICC,
	or otherwise provide electronic access to, all data requested by
	GBICC relating to workers' compensation insurance coverage,
	claims, appeals, compliance, and enforcement under Chapter 97 of
	the General Statutes.
	b. The North Carolina Rate Bureau (Bureau) shall release to GBICC, or

- otherwise provide electronic access to, all data requested by GBICC relating to workers' compensation insurance coverage, claims, business ratings, and premiums under Chapter 58 of the General Statutes. The Bureau shall be immune from civil liability for releasing information pursuant to this subsection, even if the information is erroneous, provided the Bureau acted in good faith and without malicious or willful intent to harm in releasing the information.
- <u>c.</u> The Department of Commerce, Division of Employment Security (DES), shall release to GBICC, or otherwise provide access to, all data requested by GBICC relating to unemployment insurance



SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
