## 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALL TEACHERS HAVE DUTY-FREE INSTRUCTIONAL

3 PLANNING TIME AND DUTY-FREE LUNCH.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-301.1 reads as rewritten:

### 6 "§ 115C-301.1. Duty-free instructional planning time.time and duty-free lunch.

7 All full-time assigned classroom teachers shall be provided daily duty-free instructional 8 planning time during regular student contact hours. The duty-free instructional planning time 9 shall be provided except in emergency situations where the immediate and temporary 10 suspension of the planning time is the only reasonable means of protecting the safety of the 11 students. The duty-free lunch shall be provided to the maximum extent that (i)-the safety and 12 proper supervision of children the students may allow during regular student contact hours and 13 (ii) insofar as funds are provided for this purpose by the General Assembly. If the safety and 14 supervision of children does not allow duty-free instructional planning time during regular 15 student contact hours for a given teacher, the funds provided by the General Assembly for the duty-free instructional planning time for that teacher shall revert to the general fund. hours. 16 17 Principals shall not unfairly burden a given teacher by making that teacher give up his or her 18 duty-free instructional planning time or duty-free lunch on an ongoing, regular basis without 19 the consent of the teacher."

SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-105.27(b) reads as rewritten:

21 School Improvement Plan. - In order to improve student performance, the school "(b) 22 improvement team at each school shall develop a school improvement plan that takes into 23 consideration the annual performance goal for that school that is set by the State Board under 24 G.S. 115C-105.35 and the goals set out in the mission statement for the public schools adopted 25 by the State Board of Education. All school improvement plans shall be, to the greatest extent 26 possible, data-driven. School improvement teams shall use the Education Value-Added 27 Assessment System (EVAAS) or a compatible and comparable system approved by the State 28 Board of Education to (i) analyze student data and identify root causes for problems, (ii) 29 determine actions to address them, and (iii) appropriately place students in courses such as 30 Algebra I. School improvement plans shall contain clear, unambiguous targets, explicit 31 indicators and actual measures, and expeditious time frames for meeting the measurement 32 standards.

(1) Shall include a plan for the use of staff development funds that may be made available to the school by the local board of education to implement the school improvement plan. The plan may provide that a portion of these
