Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A LICENSE TO OPERATE A BEACH BINGO GAME, TO 3 AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO CHARGE AND 4 COLLECT THAT LICENSING FEE. AND TO MAKE IT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE TO 5 VIOLATE THE BEACH BINGO LICENSING REQUIREMENTS. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-309.14 is amended by adding the following new subdivision: 8 A person shall not operate a beach bingo game at any location without first "(5) 9 obtaining a license as provided by this subdivision. Any person operating a beach bingo game without a license is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor. The 10 11 procedure for obtaining an application for a beach bingo license shall be as 12 follows: 13 The application for a beach bingo license shall be made to the <u>a.</u> 14 Department of Public Safety on a form prescribed by the 15 Department. The Department shall charge an initial application fee of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and an annual renewal fee of three 16 hundred dollars (\$300.00) to defray the cost of issuing beach bingo 17 18 licenses and handling enforcement. The fees collected shall be 19 deposited in the General Fund of the State. This license shall expire one year after the granting of the license but may be renewed yearly 20 21 upon payment of the renewal fee. 22 Each application and renewal application shall contain all of the b. 23 following information: 24 The name and address of the applicant and if the applicant is <u>1.</u> 25 a corporation, association, or other similar legal entity, the 26 name and home address of each of the officers of the 27 organization as well as the name and address of the directors, or other persons similarly situated, of the organization. 28 29 The location at which the applicant will conduct the bingo <u>2.</u> games. If the premises are leased, a copy of the lease or rental 30 31 agreement. 32 Any false information provided in an application for a beach bingo <u>c.</u> license is cause for suspension of that license and is also a Class 2 33 34 misdemeanor. All books, papers, records, and documents relevant to determining 35 <u>d.</u> whether an individual has acted or is acting in compliance with this 36



section shall be open to inspection by the Department of Public Safety at reasonable times and during reasonable hours."

**SECTION 2.** The Department of Public Safety may take the necessary actions to develop and implement the application process. Beginning October 1, 2015, the Department of Public Safety may accept applications, charge and collect application fees, and issue licenses as provided by G.S. 14-309.14(5) as enacted by this act.

**SECTION 3.** Except as provided otherwise, Section 1 of this act becomes effective December 1, 2015, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date. G.S. 14-309(5)c. as enacted by Section 1 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to applications submitted on or after October 1, 2015, and offenses committed on or after that date. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
