A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO DEVELOP A PROCESS TO ALLOW THE INCLUSION OF A CONCEALED CARRY HANDGUN ENDORSEMENT ON A PERSON'S DRIVERS LICENSE TO ALLOW A PERSON TO PRESENT HIS OR HER DRIVERS LICENSE FOR PURPOSES OF COMPLYING WITH THE CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT LAWS OF THIS STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Development of Process. – The Division of Motor Vehicles, in consultation with the North Carolina Sheriffs' Association and the Administrative Office of the Courts, shall develop a process whereby a concealed carry handgun endorsement may be included on a person's drivers license upon request to allow a person to present his or her drivers license for purposes of complying with G.S. 14-415.11.

**SECTION 2.** Report. – The Division of Motor Vehicles shall develop the process required by Section 1 of this act by no later than February 1, 2016. Upon developing the process required by Section 1 of this act, the Division of Motor Vehicles shall provide a report to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee detailing the process developed, including any statutory changes necessary to implement the process.

**SECTION 3.** Effective Date. – This act is effective when it becomes law.
