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1	(5) No teacher of record shall be prohibited from administering tests required		
2	through State or local testing programs to students assigned to that teacher,		
3	except when testing modifications are necessary.		
4	These policies shall reflect standard testing practices to insure reliability and validity of the		
5	sample testing. The results of the field tests shall be used in the final design of each test. The		
6	State Board of Education's policies regarding the testing of children with disabilities shall (i)		
7	provide broad accommodations and alternate methods of assessment that are consistent with a		
8	student's individualized education program and section 504 (29 U.S.C. § 794) plans, (ii)		
9	prohibit the use of statewide tests as the sole determinant of decisions about a student's		
10	graduation or promotion, and (iii) provide parents with information about the Statewide Testing		
11	Program and options for children with disabilities. The State Board shall report its proposed		
12	policies and proposed changes in policies to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight		
13	Committee prior to adoption.		
14	The State Board of Education may appoint an Advisory Council on Testing to assist in		
15	carrying out its responsibilities under this Article."
