BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 255 makes various changes to the law relating to the State Building Code. Section 4.1 amends the threshold for requirement of a building permit for any construction, installation, repair, replacement, or alteration from \$5,000 to \$15,000.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

Because the bill raises the threshold for requirement of a building permit, fewer permits will be required, resulting in a loss of local government fee revenue. Because no data is available on the number of permits that are issued between the \$5,000 and \$15,000 thresholds, no estimate is available.
