6	SECTION 1. G.S. 148-132 reads as rewritten:

8	The Section of Correction Enterprises of the Division of Adult Correction is empowered and			
9	authorized to market and sell products and services produced by Correction Enterprises to any of			
10	the following entities:			
11	(1)	Any public agency or institution owned, managed, or controlled by the State.		
12	(2)	Any county, city, or town in this State.		
13	(3)	Any federal, state, or local public agency or institution in any other state of the		
14		union.		
15	(4)	An entity or organization that has tax-exempt status pursuant to section		
16		501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Products purchased by an entity		
17		pursuant to this subdivision may not be resold.		
18	(5)	Any current employee or retiree of the State of North CarolinaCarolina,		
19		member, employee, or retiree of the North Carolina National Guard, or of a unit		
20		of local government of this State, verified through federal or State-issued		
21		identification, or through proof of retirement status, but purchases by a State		
22		employee or retiree, National Guard member, employee, or retiree, or local		
23		governmental employee or retiree may not exceed two thousand five hundred		
24		dollars (\$2,500) during any calendar year. Products purchased by State		
25		employees or retirees, National Guard members, employees or retirees, and		
26		local governmental employees and retirees under this section may not be resold.		
27	(6)	Private contractors when the goods purchased will be used to perform work		
28		under a contract with a public agency."
