5	SECTION 1. The following procedures for nominating and electing members	of the
6	Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina (hereinafter the "Board of Govern	
7	are adopted:	, ,
8	I. COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES.	
9	1. It is the duty of the University Board of Governors Nominating Com	nittee
10	(hereinafter the "Committee") to conduct a process for nominating and electing persons for	each
1	opening on the Board of Governors to which the House of Representatives is to elect member	S.
2	2. The Committee shall receive nominations for election to the Board	rd of
3	Governors from Monday, March 6, 2017, through Friday, March 10, 2017. In 2017, the	
14	number of positions available for election by the House of Representatives is six, and	
5	position is for a four-year term. Each Representative may nominate up to two persons. In ord	
16	a person to have standing as a nominee, that person must be formally nominated by a memb	
17	the House of Representatives. Only a written nomination that includes all the requ	
18	information, which is submitted on a form provided by the Chair of the Committee for	
19 20	purpose, and that is received in the Office of the House Principal Clerk on or after Monday, N	
20 21	6, 2017, and no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, March 10, 2017, shall constitute a for nomination of an individual. Delivery to the Office of the House Principal Clerk by faces	
21	transmission or e-mail transmission shall not constitute a formal nomination of an individual	
23	individual is not eligible for nomination by a member of the House of Representatives if he of

26	3. Notwithstanding G.S. 138A-22, every person who has been formally nomi	nated
27	shall file a completed Statement of Economic Interest as required by law. In order	
28	nomination to be complete and eligible for consideration, the Statement of Economic Interest	
29	be filed no later than 5:00 P.M. on Friday, March 10, 2017. The Statement of Economic In	
30	must clearly state that the person has been nominated for the Board of Governors of	The

31 University of North Carolina.

32 4. After the close of the nomination period on March 10, 2017, the Committee 33 shall list all proposed nominees. The Committee shall screen the nominees as to their



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1	qualifications, experience, and statutory suitability. The Committee may screen nominees by
2	interviewing or by soliciting written information or by both means. On completion of the
3	screening process, the Committee shall conduct a vote to ensure that the slate of legally qualified
4	nominees lists 12 nominees if 12 or more have been nominated.
5	5. Each nominee shall confirm his or her willingness to serve if elected. Any
6	nominee may withdraw without the approval of the sponsor.
7	6. The Committee's nominees shall be placed before and recommended to the
8	House of Representatives for election.
9	II. ELECTIONS IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.
10	1. A ballot shall be prepared under the supervision of the Chair of the Committee
11	for the use of the House of Representatives. The ballot shall include 12 legally qualified nominees
12	if 12 or more have been nominated.
13	2. The names of the nominees shall be arranged on the ballot by alphabetical order
14	by surname and shall list only the names of those nominees recommended by the Committee.
15	3. The House of Representatives shall hold its election no later than the beginning
16	of the daily session on Wednesday, April 5, 2017. Before the voting begins, the Speaker of the
17	House shall explain the voting rules, which are:
18	(a) No nomination shall be received from the floor.
19	(b) In order to be elected, a nominee must receive the votes of a majority of all
20	members present and voting.
21	(c) Each member present and voting shall vote for as many nominees as there are
22	positions to be filled and any ballot not so marked shall be deemed void.
23	(d) If fewer than six nominees receive the votes of a majority of all members
24	present and voting, a runoff to fill the open position or positions shall be
25	conducted among the nominees who were not elected but who received the
26	highest numbers of votes cast, and the number of nominees eligible to be voted
27	on in the runoff shall be twice the number of positions to be filled.
28	(e) If there is a tie for the last position between two nominees who are eligible for
29	the next runoff, both nominees shall be included in the next runoff balloting,
30	even though there would be more than two nominees per available position.
31	(f) If more than six nominees receive the votes of a majority of all members
32	present and voting, then the six nominees receiving the highest numbers of
33	votes shall be deemed to have been chosen.
34	4. The members of the House of Representatives shall proceed to mark their
35	ballots for six persons for four-year terms. Every ballot shall be signed by the member of the
36	House of Representatives casting it, and no unsigned ballots shall be counted.
37	5. The Chair of the Committee is responsible for canvassing the vote and
38	declaring the results and may designate members of the Committee to assist. All ballots shall be
39	retained by the House Principal Clerk as part of the permanent records of the House of
40	Representatives and shall be open for immediate public inspection upon adjournment of that day's
41	session.
42	6. When the Chair of the Committee has determined that the House of
43	Representatives has chosen six persons to serve as members of the Board of Governors for terms
44	of four years, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall entertain a motion for the
45	simultaneous election of those persons by the House of Representatives to the indicated positions
46	and for the indicated terms. The vote shall then be called electronically. If a majority of those
47	voting shall vote "aye" and it is orally confirmed, those six persons named in the motion shall be
48	declared to have been elected to the Board of Governors by the House of Representatives.
49	7. The results of the election in the House of Representatives shall then be sent by
50	Special Messenger to the Senate.
51	III. NOTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS.

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1 When the election process is complete, the Chair of the Committee shall notify the 2 Secretary of the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina of the names of the 3 persons elected by the House of Representatives and the term for which each person was elected.

- 4 **SECTION 2.** As used in this resolution, the term "Chair" means the Chair of the 5 University Board of Governors Nominating Committee.
- 6 **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
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
