Short Title: Enhanced Penalty for Second Degree Trespass. (Public) Representatives Brenden Jones, Murphy, Grange, and Malone (Primary Sponsors: Sponsors). Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR SECOND DEGREE TRESPASS ONTO CERTAIN PREMISES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-159.13 reads as rewritten: "§ 14-159.13. Second degree trespass. Offense. - A person commits the offense of second degree trespass if, without authorization, he enters or remains on premises of another: After he has been notified not to enter or remain there by the owner, by a (1) person in charge of the premises, by a lawful occupant, or by another authorized person; or That are posted, in a manner reasonably likely to come to the attention of (2) intruders, with notice not to enter the premises. Classification. – Second Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, second (b) degree trespass is a Class 3 misdemeanor. A violation of subsection (a) of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor if the offense occurs in a multi-occupancy bathroom, shower, or changing facility." SECTION 2.
