SI	ECTION 1. The Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public	
Safety shall s	tudy the use of dual arrest in cases of domestic violence to determine whether dual	
arrest should be adopted in North Carolina.		
SI	ECTION 2. In conducting the study, the Committee shall consider all of the

SECTION 1. The Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety shall study the use of dual arrest in cases of domestic violence to determine whether dual arrest should be adopted in North Carolina. SECTION 2. In conducting the study, the Committee shall consider all of the following: (1) The State's current laws, rules, or practices relating to domestic violence cases. (2) What domestic violence cases would be appropriate for law enforcement officers to utilize dual arrest. (3) What measures should be taken if minor children are present and the law enforcement officer believes dual arrest is necessary.
