

1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY TO WATAUGA COUNTY SCHOOLS
3	IN ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.
4	Whereas, the local board of education for Watauga County Schools should be able to
5	schedule school opening and closing dates for any school located in that local school
6	administrative unit to coincide with the opening and closing dates of Caldwell Community
7	College; and
8	Whereas, school calendar flexibility would benefit all students in Watauga County
9	Schools who are enrolled in classes through Caldwell Community College by allowing them to
10	align their fall and spring semesters with the fall and spring semesters at Caldwell Community
11	College; and
12	Whereas, school calendar flexibility would allow Watauga County Schools and
13	Caldwell Community College to meet the workforce development needs in Watauga County more
14	effectively than the current structure by helping high school and college students develop the skills
15	necessary for business and industry; Now, therefore,
16	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
17	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:
18	"(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates of
19	opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for
20	year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closest to
21	August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June 11. On
22	a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that the
23	opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow the
24	local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 19, to
25	the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated
26	makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled closing date if
27	necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or
28	instructional time. For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in
29	any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during any
30	four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or
31	other emergency situations.
32	The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school that
33	a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to any
34	school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of modified
35	calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."

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SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the
2017-2018 school year.
