	erson may knowingly manufacture, sell, or offer for sale any covered product	
that contains intentionally added PFAS in this State. A manufacturer of a covered product shall		
provide persons that offer the covered product for sale in this State with a certificate of		
compliance stating, at a minimum, that the covered product is in compliance with the		
requirements of this Part and does not contain any intentionally added PFAS. A certificate of		
compliance provided under this subsection shall be signed by an authorized official or		
representative of the manufacturer. The certificate of compliance may be provided to persons		
through electronic means.		
(c) This Part shall not apply to the sale or resale of used products."		
<b>SECTION 2.(a)</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of		
Environmental Quality the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in nonrecurring		
funds for the 2024-2025 fiscal year to implement the provisions of this act.		
	<b>TION 2.(b)</b> This section becomes effective July 1, 2024.	
	<b>TION 3.</b> Except as otherwise provided, this act becomes effective October 1,
