HOUSE BILL 774

Short Title: Passing Parked Emergency Vehicle.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR HOW DRIVERS SHALL OPERATE THEIR MOTOR
VEHICLES WHEN PASSING PARKED EMERGENCY VEHICLES THAT
HAVE THEIR EMERGENCY LIGHTS ILLUMINATED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-157 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(f) When an authorized emergency vehicle that is giving a warning signal as described in subsection (a) of this section is parked, the driver of every other vehicle shall, as soon as it is safe and when not otherwise directed by an individual lawfully directing traffic, do one of the following:

(1) When driving on an interstate highway or other highway with more than two lanes traveling in the direction of the emergency vehicle, merge into the lane farthest from the emergency vehicle.

(2) When driving on a two lane road, slow to a speed that is 20 miles per hour less than the posted speed limit."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
