7	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
Q	"(a1) County Tay for Economic Dayslonment A county may lavy a tay of not

"(c1) County Tax for Economic Development. — A county may levy a tax of not more than five dollars (\$5.00) per year on any vehicle resident in the county. The proceeds of the tax may be used only for economic development projects within the county."

SECTION 2. This act applies to Chatham County only, and only the Chatham County Economic Development Commission may use the funds.

SECTION 3. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years beginning on or after July 1, 2001.
