| 3  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:   |
| 4  | SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the                          |
| 5  | Department of Health and Human Services the sum of five hundred thousand dollars       |
| 6  | (\$500,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars |
| 7  | (\$500,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated as follows:  |
| 8  | (1) \$400,000 in each fiscal year for the 10 counties most in need of access           |
| 9  | to perinatal care for non-Medicaid low-income women.                                   |
| 10 | (2) \$100,000 in each fiscal year for 10 community coalitions to address               |
| 11 | gaps in local perinatal health care services.  |
| 12 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.                             |
