3	NOTIFY THE STATE BOARD OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT
4	EXAMINERS WHEN THEY PERFORM WORK IN THIS STATE,
5	AUTHORIZING THE BOARD TO INCREASE FEES, AND AMENDING
6	CERTAIN PROVISIONS RELATING TO CERTIFIED PUBLIC
7	ACCOUNTANTS.
8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
9	SECTION 1. G.S. 93-10 reads as rewritten:
10	"§ 93-10. Persons certified in other states.
11	An individual who holds a valid and unrevoked certificate and license or permit to
12	practice as a certified public accountant, or its equivalent, issued under authority of any
13	state, territory of the United States, or the District of Columbia, and who resides without
14	the State of North Carolina, outside this State, may perform work within the State:
15	Provided, that he register within this State if the person notifies the State Board of
16	Certified Public Accountant Examiners and Examiners that the person is performing
17	work in this State, agrees to comply with itsthe provisions of this Chapter and rules
18	adopted by the Board regarding such registration.notification and practice, pays an
19	annual fee not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), and notwithstanding G.S. 150B-38,
20 21	consents to have notice of hearing served on the licensing board in the person's principal
21 22	state of business."
22	SECTION 2. G.S. 93-12(7) reads as rewritten: "(7) To charge for each examination provided for in this Chapter a fee not
23 24	exceeding two <u>four</u> hundred dollars (\$200.00).(\$400.00). This fee shall
24 25	be payable to the secretary treasurer of the Board by the applicant at
23 26	the time of filing application. In no case shall the examination fee be
20 27	refunded, unless in the discretion of the Board the applicant shall be
28	deemed ineligible for examination. In addition to the examination fee,
20	deemed mengible for examination. <u>In addition to the examination ree</u> ,

1	if the Board uses a testing service for the preparation, administration,
2	or grading of examinations, the Board may charge the applicant the
3	actual cost of the examination services. The applicant shall pay all fees
4	and costs associated with the examination at the time the application is
5	filed with the Board. Examination fees and costs shall not be refunded
6	unless the Board deems the applicant ineligible for examination."
7	SECTION 3. G.S. 93-12(7a) reads as rewritten:
8	"(7a) To charge for each initial certificate of qualification provided for in
9	this Chapter a fee not exceeding seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).one
10	hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00)."
11	SECTION 4. G.S. 93-12(8) reads as rewritten:
12	"(8) To require the renewal of all certificates of qualification annually on
13	the first day of July, and to charge an annual renewal fee not to exceed
14	fifty dollars (\$50.00).one hundred dollars (\$100.00)."
15	SECTION 5. G.S. 93-12(8c)f. reads as rewritten:
16	"f. For purposes of this section, a firm means an entity,
17	individualsole proprietorship, partnershippartnership, registered
18	limited liability partnership, professional limited liability
19	<u>company</u> , or professional association corporation through which
20	one or more certificate holder holders engages in the public
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	practice of accountancy through an office or offices.office."
22	SECTION 6. This act is effective when it becomes law.
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
