The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 20-97 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
"(c1) County Tax for Economic Development. – A county may levy a tax of not		
more than five dollars (\$5.00) per year on any vehicle resident in the county. The		
proceeds of the tax may be used only for economic development projects within the		
county."		
\mathbf{S}	ECTION 2. This act applies to Chatham County only a	and only the
Chatham County Economic Development Commission may use the funds.		
SECTION 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 2002.
