| 7 | SECTION 1. G.S. 8-53.6 reads as rewritten: |
| 8 | "§ 8-53.6. No disclosure in alimony and divorce actions. |
| 9 | In an action pursuant to G.S. 50-5, 50-5.1, 50-6, 50-7, 50-16.2 50-16.2A, and |
| 10 | 50-16.3 50-16.3A if either or both of the parties have sought and obtained marital |
| 11 | counseling by a licensed physician, licensed psychologist, licensed psychological |
| 12 | associate, licensed clinical social worker, or certified marital family therapist, licensed |
| 13 | marriage and family therapist, the person or persons rendering such counseling shall not |
| 14 | be competent to testify in the action concerning information acquired while rendering |
| 15 | such counseling." |
| 16 | SECTION 2. G.S. 8-53.7 reads as rewritten: |
| 17 | "§ 8-53.7. Social worker privilege. |
| 18 | No person engaged in delivery of private social work services, duly certified |
| 19 | pursuant to Chapter 90B of the General Statutes shall be required to disclose any |
| 20 | information which he or she may have acquired in rendering professional social |
| 21 | services, and which information was necessary to enable him or her to render |
| 22 | professional social services: provided, that the presiding judge of a superior or district |
| 23 | court may compel such disclosure, if in the court's opinion the same is necessary to a |
| 24 | proper administration of justice and such disclosure is not prohibited by G.S. 8-53.6 or |
| 25 | any other statute or regulation." |
| 26 | SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001, and applies to |

27 information acquired on or after that date.
