5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 96-15 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
7	"(1) Attorneys' Fees. – Notwithstanding G.S. 96-17(b1), the Commission may, in
8	its discretion, reimburse expenses including attorneys' fees, to the extent that the
9	General Assembly appropriates funds for that purpose, not to exceed five hundred
10	dollars (\$500.00), when a party's claim for unemployment insurance or tax rate
11	adjustment pending before an appeals referee or the Commission, is required to be
12	reconvened due to records or transcripts being lost or unavailable as needed for timely
13	review due to fault of the Commission."
14	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
