A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF MCFARLAN TO PROVIDE FOUR-YEAR TERMS FOR THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of the Charter of the Town of McFarlan, being Chapter 102, Private Laws of 1885, as rewritten by Section 4 of Chapter 771 of the Session Laws of 1947, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 4. That hereafter the officers of said town shall consist of a mayor and five commissioners, and an election for said officers shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May, 1947, and biennally in 2007 and quadrennially thereafter, and shall be conducted in accordance with the general municipal election laws as set out in Article 3 of Chapter 160 Chapter 163 of the General Statutes of North Carolina. Those elected in 2007 and thereafter shall serve four-year terms."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
