5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the issue of
7	increasing the membership of the Wildlife Resources Commission by adding two
8	members who own and hunt with dogs, one who is a resident of a county that is located
9	east of or is traversed by Interstate 95, and one who is a resident of a county that is
10	located west of or is traversed by State Highway 52. The Legislative Research
11	Commission may also study other issues related to the regulation of wildlife in this State
12	in the discretion of the Commission.
13	SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission shall report the results
14	of this study, including any legislative recommendations, to the 2007 General
15	Assembly.
16	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
