A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN INVENTORY OF STATE  
INFRASTRUCTURE, INCLUDING MODERN COMMUNICATIONS  
TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Center for Geographic Information and Analysis, the sum of two hundred ninety-four thousand dollars (\$294,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish an inventory of the State's infrastructure.

North Carolina's infrastructure consists of the essential facilities, services, and installations needed for the functioning and thriving of a community. Specifically, the infrastructure includes modern: communication and technology systems, transportation, energy, water-related services, health-related services, and public educational institutions.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
