A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN INVENTORY OF STATE 3 INFRASTRUCTURE, INCLUDING MODERN **COMMUNICATIONS** 4 TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 6 7 Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Center for Geographic Information and Analysis, the sum of two hundred ninety-four thousand dollars (\$294,000) in 8 nonrecurring funds for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish an inventory of the State's 9 10 infrastructure. 11 North Carolina's infrastructure consists of the essential facilities, services, and

12 installations needed for the functioning and thriving of a community. Specifically, the 13 infrastructure includes modern: communication and technology systems, transportation, 14 energy, water-related services, health-related services, and public educational 15 institutions.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
