6	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-190.13(3) reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 14-190.13. Definitions for certain offenses concerning minors.
8	The following definitions apply to G.S. 14-190.14, displaying material harmful to
9	minors; G.S. 14-190.15, disseminating or exhibiting to minors harmful material or
10	performances; G.S. 14-190.16, first degree sexual exploitation of a minor;
11	G.S. 14-190.17, second degree sexual exploitation of a minor; G.S. 14-190.17A, third
12	degree sexual exploitation of a minor; G.S. 14-190.18, promoting prostitution of a
13	minor; and G.S. 14-190.19, participating in prostitution of a minor.
14	
15	(3) Minor. – An individual who is less than 18 years old and is not
16	married or judicially emancipated.of age."
17	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
18	offenses committed on or after that date.
