AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS YOUTH PROJECTS IN EDGECOMBE AND NASH COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bridging the Gap of Eastern North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to provide support services to youth in Edgecombe and Nash Counties. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$50,000 for the Adolescents Pursuing Purpose Thru Leadership Enhancement (APPLE) Program, a juvenile reentry program for young males.
- (2) \$50,000 for the Mentoring Children of Prisoners' Project, which matches mentors with children from Edgecombe and Nash Counties who have a parent incarcerated in a State or federal prison.
- (3) \$50,000 for the Edgecombe and Nash Counties Out-of-School Project, which provides youth with mentoring and tutorial support.

SECTION 2.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to Edgecombe County the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to support the One Plus One Equals Success Program, a summer math and reading tutorial program for children in kindergarten through eighth grade.

SECTION 2.(b) There is appropriated from the General Fund to Nash County the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to support the One Plus One Equals Success Program, a summer math and reading tutorial program for children in kindergarten through eighth grade.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
