April 4, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR A **PILOT PROGRAM** TO **ENHANCE** RECRUITMENT OF MINORITY STUDENTS INTO PHARMACY SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: There is appropriated from the General Fund to the SECTION 1. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to support the Minority Pharmacy Recruitment Program.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
