A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND  
3 HUMAN SERVICES FOR A PILOT PROGRAM TO ENHANCE  
4 RECRUITMENT OF MINORITY STUDENTS INTO PHARMACY SCHOOLS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
7 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three  
8 hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of three  
9 hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall  
10 be used to support the Minority Pharmacy Recruitment Program.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
