5	SECTION 1. G.S. 135-90(b) reads as rewritten:				
6	"(b) The purpose of the Article is to attract and hold qualified employees and				
7	officials of the State of North Carolina and its political subdivisions by permitting them				
8	to participate encouraging them to participate, by automatic enrollment or otherwise, in				
9	a profit sharing or salary reduction form of deferred compensation which will provide				
10	supplemental retirement income payments upon retirement, disability, termination,				
11	hardship, and death as allowed under section 401(k), or any other relevant section, of				
12	the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended. As used in this Article, the term				
13	"profit" means the excess revenue over expenditures prior to the expenditure of the				
14	amount which may be optionally made available for employees to be placed in trust by				
15	the State and its political subdivisions on behalf of the employees and officials covered				
16	by this Article."				
17	SECTION 2. G.S. 135-92(a) reads as rewritten:				
18	"(a) The membership eligibility of the Supplemental Retirement Income Plan				
19	shall consist of any of the following who voluntarily elect to enroll: who either				
20	voluntarily elect to enroll or who decide not to opt out of automatic enrollment:				
21	(1) Members of the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System;

23	(2) Members of the Consolidated Judicial Retirement System; and				
24	(3) Members of the Legislative Retirement System; and				
25	(4) Members of the Local Governmental Employees' Retirement System;

10	"(a)	Each	member may elect to reduce his compensation by the amount of his
11	contributi	ion to t	he Supplemental Retirement Income Plan and that amount shall be held
12	in the m	ember'	s account. Members electing such a reduction in compensation may
13	authorize	payrol	Il deductions for making contributions to the Plan. For purposes of this
14	subsectio	n, the t	term "elect" includes electing not to opt out of automatic enrollment in
15	the Suppl	ementa	al Retirement Income Plan."
16		SECT	FION 4. G.S. 135-94(a2) reads as rewritten:
17	"(a)	The D	Department of State Treasurer and the Board of Trustees shall establish a
18	schedule	of su	applemental retirement income benefits for all members of the
19	Suppleme	ental R	etirement Income Plan, subject to the following limitations:

21		(2)	All amounts maintained in a member's account shall be invested
22			according to the member's election, as approved by the Department of
23			State Treasurer and Board of Trustees, including but not limited to, a
24			time deposit account, a fixed investment account, or a variable
25			investment account. Transfers of accumulated funds shall be permitted
26			among the various approved forms of investment. For purposes of this
27			subsection, the term "election" includes an election not to opt out of
28			automatic enrollment in the Supplemental Retirement Income Plan.

30		SECT	FION 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
